#### DANCE ENROLLMENT

Chart 1, Chart 2, and Chart 4 provide information on dance major enrollment, number of degrees awarded in dance, and percentage of credits generated in courses designed for non-dance majors.

**Chart 1** includes the number of institutions offering a specific major, dance major enrollment in major areas for Summer and Fall 2018, and the number of degrees awarded during the period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018.

**Example:** Chart 1-2 – "Total Dance Student Enrollment, All Institutions," Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree Programs or Equivalent (65% Dance Content).

During 2018-2019, 12 institutions offered majors in Choreography/Performance. In those schools, 84 students were enrolled in Summer 2018; 630 students were enrolled in Fall 2018; and 113 students graduated between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018.

**Chart 2** is a synopsis of Chart 1 by size and type of institution. There are three charts: private institutions, public institutions, and all institutions. There is also a figure in each chart for total enrollment (all programs) in that category of institution.

**Example:** Chart 2-3 – "Dance Major Enrollment by Size and Type of Institution," All Institutions.

Forty-six schools offer baccalaureate liberal arts degree programs in dance. In those schools, 394 dance major students were enrolled in baccalaureate liberal arts degree programs in Summer 2018; 2,020 were enrolled in Fall 2018; and 401 students graduated between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018.

**Chart 4** analyzes the percentage of credit hours (either quarter or semester hours) generated by non-dance major students.

**Example:** Chart 4 – "Percentage of Semester Hours Generated by Non-Major Students," Public Institutions.

The average percentage of semester hours generated by non-dance major students in the 71 institutions in this category is 47%. The percentiles also provide a range of data for comparison.

#### **DANCE FACULTY NUMBERS**

**Charts 5 through 13** provide a variety of calculations of the number of full-time faculty members. The charts calculate the number of faculty members by gender, highest degree earned, academic rank, length of service at the same institution, and tenure status. Chart 12-2 shows information regarding average numbers of faculty members and average instructional FTE.

**Example:** Chart 10 – "Dance Faculty by Gender and Length of Service: Institutions Categorized by Type of Support," Public Institutions, Women.

At the 71 public institutions reporting faculty data by gender, 84 female faculty members have been employed full-time for 1-4 years; 61 have been employed for 5-9 years; and 159 have been employed for 10 years or more at the same institution. These figures are based on a total of 304 female faculty members at public institutions, representing 65% of all faculty members at schools that reported faculty data by gender.

- (1) Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to 100%.
- (2) Some respondents are unable to provide faculty data by gender. Therefore, this combined total has more entries than the sum of the individual male and female entries.

## DANCE FACULTY SALARIES AND PART-TIME FACULTY DATA

Charts 14 through 19 provide data on salaries for faculty members, and more detailed information on part-time faculty members.

Charts 14 through 16 provide salary statistics for the 2018-2019 academic year by rank for male, female, and all full-time faculty members. The charts include lowest and highest individual salaries, as well as average institutional salaries and the various percentiles. Salaries are based on a nine-month academic year excluding benefits.

**Example:** Chart 14 – "Full-Time Faculty Salaries: Male," Public Institutions.

Twenty-six public institutions reported male Associate Professors. Their average salary was \$77,764. The lowest individual salary of any male Associate Professor in this category was \$51,691 and the highest individual salary was \$110,000. The other figures on this line represent percentile rankings of the average salaries for male Associate Professors employed by institutions in this category.

Charts 17 through 19 provide data on part-time instruction at each school: average number of persons employed, average total full-time equivalence (FTE), average part-time salaries, and average percentage of total instructional FTE (full- and part-time). There are sections for part-time faculty with faculty status (individuals who have rank and are considered faculty members by the institution), adjunct faculty and teaching associates (individuals without faculty rank who teach at the institution and who are not graduate students), and graduate teaching assistants and teaching associates (graduate students who teach courses at the institution). Chart 17 provides data for part-time male faculty, Chart 18 provides data for part-time female faculty, and Chart 19 covers all part-time faculty.

**Example:** Chart 19 – "Part-Time Instruction: All Part-Time Faculty," Adjunct Faculty or Teaching Associates, Private Institutions.

At 14 private institutions with part-time adjunct faculty or teaching associates, the average number of persons is 11.79. The average combined part-time workload of all adjunct faculty or teaching associates at an institution was 3.76. The average salary expenditure per individual in this category was \$9,678; and adjunct faculty or teaching associates on this line represented an average of 32% of the total instructional FTE.

#### DANCE ADMINISTRATION

Charts 20 and 21 provide information on salaries for dance executives and assistant/associate dance executives for the 2018-2019 academic year. There are separate charts for salaries based on nine/ten months (Chart 20) and eleven/twelve months (Chart 21). The charts reflect gross annual salary excluding benefits.

**Example:** Chart 21 – "Dance Executives' Salaries Based on Eleven or Twelve Months," Public Institutions.

Thirty-four institutions reported dance executive salaries in this category. The average salary was \$108,948. The percentiles range from \$69,521 to \$161,560.

**Chart 22** describes the appointment process for dance executives.

**Example:** Chart 22 – "Dance Executives' Appointment Process," Public Institutions.

Of the 58 public institutions reporting, 61% of executives are appointed by administration; 38% are elected by faculty; and 71% are subject to formal review on an average of every 3 years.

**Chart 23** analyzes the average amount of time spent on specific responsibilities by dance executives and assistant or associate dance executives.

**Example:** Chart 23 – "Executives' Job Analysis: Average Percentage of Time Spent," Public Institutions.

Dance executives at 58 public institutions spend an average of 24% of time teaching, 14% on research/creative activities, 49% on administrative matters, 8% on service, and 9% on fundraising.

**Chart 24** provides data on personnel assignments in the areas of secretarial/clerical assistance, library staff, and professional/technical staff.

*Example:* Chart 24-1 – "Dance Administrative and Staff Assistance," Private Institutions.

At 15 private institutions, the average full-time equivalent (FTE) secretarial/clerical staff is .95 and the average salary expenditure is \$34,266.

Charts 25-1 through 25-10 provide information on expenses for specific budget categories of dance units. Charts 25-1 to 25-3 include specific instructional or operational expenditures, Charts 25-4 to 25-6 include specific production expenditures for summer, Charts 25-7 to 25-9 include specific production expenses for the academic year, and Chart 25-10 includes expenses per production. In all cases, the charts represent average expenses and percentile rankings for various budget categories and totals.

**Example:** Chart 25-1 – "Expenses of the Dance Unit: All Private Institutions," Specific Instructional and Operational Expenses, Faculty/Professional Travel.

Fifteen private institutions included faculty/professional travel in their 2018-2019 dance unit budget. The average expense was \$11,494. Also included in the chart are percentile rankings.

**Chart 25-11** provides information on actual expenses for specific budget categories in 2017-2018 of all dance units. The chart represents average expenses and percentile rankings for various budget categories and totals.

**Example:** Chart 25-11 – "Expenses of the Dance Unit: All Institutions," Actual Instructional, Operational, and Performance Budget for 2017-2018, Faculty/Professional Travel.

Sixty-nine institutions included faculty/professional travel in their 2017-2018 dance unit budget. The average expense was \$14,214.

Chart 26 provides information on specific sources of income for the dance unit. The data included are not meant to represent the total income of the dance unit, but rather to reflect specific types of income generated specifically for the dance unit.

**Example:** Chart 26-2 – "Specific Income Sources for the Dance Unit," All Public Institutions.

Seven public institutions received public grants, the average of which was \$410,256. Percentile rankings are also presented to delineate the range of responses.

### **DANCE RATIOS**

Charts 35 through 40, and Chart 43 provide further calculations of data derived from the data survey. Each chart correlates two aspects of the dance unit's operation in order to make operational and budgetary comparisons.

**Chart 35** provides semester and quarter credit hour production per FTE faculty member, including both full- and part-time faculty.

Chart 36 provides instructional salaries for both full- and part-time faculty per semester and quarter credit hour.

Chart 37 provides total expenditures per semester and quarter credit hour production.

There are two parts to each of these three charts: one for institutions reporting semester credit hour systems and one for institutions reporting quarter credit hour systems.

**Example:** Chart 37 – "Total Expenditures Per Semester Credit Hour," Public Institutions.

At 74 institutions in this category, the average expenditure per semester credit hour was \$566. The percentile rankings are also provided.

Charts 38 through 40, and Chart 43 provide ratios using total number of dance majors as their bases. The figures used to develop the ratios are reflected in "Total Expenditures Per Dance Major Student" (Chart 38), "Number of Dance Majors Per Full-Time Faculty Member" (Chart 39), "Number of Dance Majors Per FTE Faculty Member" (Chart 40), and "Average Instructional Salary (Full- and Part-Time) Per Dance Major Student" (Chart 43). Each of these charts is presented in two versions: one covers institutions divided by size and type, and the other is based on the highest degree offered in dance.

**Example:** Chart 39 – "Number of Dance Majors Per Full-Time Faculty Member," Highest Degree Offered in Dance: Baccalaureate.

At 50 baccalaureate degree-granting institutions, the average number of dance majors per full-time faculty member is 15.1. The percentile rankings are also provided.
